

MADE EASY management has decided to facilitate those students who are not appearing in ESE-2019, but want to appear in ESE-2020. These students can either opt to attend GS classes in this session (2018-2019) or in the next session (2019-2020). These GS CARRY-ON classes will be provided after GATE -2019 examination.

Terms & Conditions

1. GS CARRY-ON facility is designed for those students who are not appearing in ESE-2019 examination and wish to appear in ESE-2020 examination. These students can either attend General Studies classes in present session (2018-19) or in next session (2019-20).
2. This facility is applicable to those students who are enrolled in ESE+GATE comprehensive batches only.
3. GS CARRY-ON classes will be conducted after GATE-2019 examination.
4. Those students who have registered for GS CARRY-ON will NOT be allowed to attend GS classes in the present session.
5. Classes of GS subjects as per the ESE syllabus (Part-1 of Preliminary Examination) will be permitted, EXCLUDING [Engineering Mathematics](#) & [Engineering Aptitude](#). Students are advised to attend Engineering Mathematics & Engineering Aptitude in the present session, as these subjects are also included in GATE syllabus.
6. Students should collect (GS books) study material in present session only.
7. These GS classes will be provided at the centre where the student has enrolled. Any request for attending these GS CARRY-ON classes at any other centre of MADE EASY will not be entertained.
8. Batch timing and venue will be informed to the GS CARRY-ON registered students. Any of the Morning/Afternoon /Evening/Weekend batches may be allotted as per the availability of seats.
9. Students should bring this form along with MADE EASY ID card while attending GS CARRY-ON classes.
10. Those students who have registered for GS CARRY-ON facility are not eligible for any kind of refund/replacement/centre transfer.
11. GS CARRY-ON is an additional facility provided by MADE EASY management to help the students.
12. **IF ANY STUDENT IS FOUND ATTENDING GS CLASSES IN CURRENT SESSION AFTER REGISTERING FOR GS CARRY-ON FACILITY, THEN HE/SHE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND ANY CLASSES IN PRESENT/NEXT SESSION AND STRICT ACTIONS WILL BE TAKEN.**
